ANNOUNCEMENT OF FUNDING AVAILABILITY INDUSTRIAL RAIL ACCESS PROGRAM

MaineDOT is currently soliciting applications for its IRAP program. The Industrial Rail Access Program (IRAP) is a Public/Private freight partnership program overseen by the Office of Freight and Business Services at MaineDOT. IRAP provides financial assistance to businesses and shippers for investment in rail or freight rail related infrastructure located on, within or adjacent to the general railroad system. The intent of the program is to stimulate economic and employment growth through generation of new or expanded freight rail service and transportation efficiencies to Maine businesses as well as to enhance intermodal transportation in the State. This State investment will be matched at a minimum 50/50 match level with local and/or private industry funds. IRAP is a competitive program with applications scored based on several criteria as outlined on the IRAP webpage at the following link: http://www.maine.gov/mdot/ofbs/irap.htm

MaineDOT currently has \$600,000 programmed for IRAP that will be available beginning July 1, 2013. Applications maybe found on the IRAP webpage with a deadline for submission of April 30, 2013.
