When Capt. Haskell left,
he understood that I was
not to go, for reasons which
he comprehended well,
but which I will not bore
with transmit.

Suffice it to say, that if I
had not voted the fort I
did, by earnest entreaty,
Exeter quota of Folk would
not have been forth coming
in due season.

" After much reflection I
decline to accept a Commission
as 2nd Lt in Co D. 2d Regt N.Y.
I intended to answer you
definitely when I was at your
office a few weeks since but
you did not fully understand
me I suppose

A. J. Gould
of your City wrote me that
the names of port of Exiles
quota could not be found
The persons referred to went
with Capt Cowan in the
First Main Cavalry Cos etc,
