Know all men by these presents, that I,
John F. Mines, of Bath, in the State of Maine,
Chaplain of the 2nd Maine Regiment of Volunteers,
do hereby constitute and appoint, George M.
Bartholomew of Hartford in the State of Connecticut,
my true and lawful Agent and Attorney, for me
and in my name and stead to receive from the
Government of the ~~United States~~ ^{State of Maine}, or the proper
Executive department thereof, whatever salary may
be due me from the said State, for services
as Chaplain, from the date of my Commission
(May 4th 1861) to the time of my being must-
ered into the service of the United States - viz:
May 28th 1861.

And, in case of the receipt of said salary as
above contemplated, by my said Attorney, I do
hereby authorize and empower him to execute for
me, and in my name, place, and stead, all
andful receipts and acquittances on account
thereof to the same effect as if I were present to
execute the same in my own proper person.
