Dear Sir. —

I take the liberty of sending the enclosed accounts to you partly by my own and partly by Maj. Gilmore's suggestion; and if it will not be too much trouble I wish you would present them to the proper authorities for settlement. You were in Portland awhile and know of my duties as mustering officer: Dr. Tewksbury lived in town; and he examined nearly eight hundred (800) recruits; I retained his list, examined the enlistments by it and was obliged to carry them to his office to get his signature, day by day, as I could get them ready; sometimes I would walk in town at evening and it would cost me a dollar to get a coach to carry me back again; there was no express office in camp and I had to carry the packages to and from town.

Col. Harding and Maj. Gilmore (who was in command at the camp nearly all of the time till the Regt. left) both say that I should be paid for these outlays; they are small, to be sure, but I can ill afford to lose them.

If you can get any settlement, I would like to have you receipt the accounts and I will give you any reasonable satisfaction.
