Hon. Samuel Cory,
Gov. of Maine:

Sir:

I have the honor to report my arrival here last evening, having been delayed by the settlement of my accounts in Washington, and by a visit which I made to the front in ascertainment of the necessary steps to be taken to re-enter the service.

Whether I shall take these steps or not, I hope to be able to inform your Excellency, without any unreasonable delay. At present I am in quite good health.

At the regiment last ^{week}, I learned that, while my letters had been sent to this Post Office as I directed, my commission had been returned to you.
