I, _____ hereby request reimbursement for reasonable costs associated with resetting disturbed property line markers on the new right of way line as outlined in State Law, 14 MRSA Section 7554-A.

I certify the following information is accurate:

The property has been surveyed by a Licensed Professional Land Surveyor on or after October 3, 1973, and a copy of the survey showing the disturbed boundary markers has been provided to Maine DOT and;

The location of the disturbed boundary markers is shown on the MaineDOT Right of Way Maps and;

The subject property is impacted by a taking in fee simple absolute that changes the point of intersection with the new right of way line and sideline boundaries or,

The subject property is bisected by a project being built on new location. New boundaries are being created by the bi-section of the parcel, so there are no existing pins to disturb. Reimbursement is intended to set pins on the new boundaries.
