Nathaniel Gurney Company B. 1st M Battery
aged 19 years five feet eleven and a half
inches high Fair Complexion Blue Eyes
Brown Hair and by profession Farmer born in
Waldo State of Maine and Enlisted at Belfast
in the State of Maine on the 9th day of October
1861, to serve for the term of three years is hereby
permitted to go to the town of Waldo in the County
of Waldo State of Maine he having received a furlough
from the 21st day of July to the 20th day of August
at which period he will rejoin his Company or
regiment at Virginia or wherever it may be or
be considered a deserter In witness whereof his tier
furnished to the said Nathaniel Gurney to the 21st
day of July and Pay to the 28th day of February
both inclusive - Given under my hand at
Hazen Town Me this 21st day of July 1862
