& enlisted again last July & fell in the
first Battle he participated - Oct 27/64
your records, no doubt show his death -
It is given in the official list of Col Shepherd
published in the Daily Whig Nov 7, 64,
Before his death his wife received letters from
him - saying he had not reced the State
Bonus, & asked her to apply for & re-
ceive it - I send full proof - & have
signed a receipt as Atty, that I
have read it, in the back of the papers
of Atty & also the application -
