Respected Sir

I take the privilege of addressing
a few lines to you in behalf of my
son Henry H Shaw of Company D
Maine 3rd Reg who is desirous of
obtaining a commission in his own
Reg or one of the new ones that is
to be formed under the late call.

And as he has been steady in the ser-
vice & been wounded in battle and
has continued all the time to do duty I
claim for him a promotion to the Lieutenant
in some of the companies now to be raised,
and if you consider the claims reasonable
and will tell me anything that I can do to
secure his election I should be highly grat-
ified, & as to Merit ~~in this case~~ I will be res-
ponsible, I saw General O.O. Howard
yesterday & he told me that he ^{would} do all he could

to assist, if convenient I wish that
you would see him as he is some
acquainted with my son & perhaps can
give you some correct idea of him
Please to write me on the result of this
& the prospect, in haste
