I presume quite a number of the men, reported in the different hospitals, have been discharged; but having received no official information of that nature, I can only report them as I have done.

I will forward in a day or two a copy of my Regt Monthly return; could not make it until a few days since, on account of a portion of the Regt being attached to another Dept and I had no communications from it;

Hereafter I shall endeavor to comply with your wishes and furnish you a copy regularly.
