

Augusta Exit 113 and Route 27 Paving Schedule

Paving operations for the I-95 Exit 113 Interchange in Augusta will be underway from Sunday night, September 15 through the next two weeks. Paving will occur overnight, weather permitting, and will involve the Exit 113 on- and off-ramps, and Route 27 according to the schedule below. Motorists should expect delays, as there will be lane closures with flaggers controlling traffic flow. Planned paving operations for this week include:

Sun. 9/15	Exit 113 NB off-ramp closed from 9 PM to 5 AM. Motorists will be advised to use Exit 109 or Exit 112.
Mon. 9/16	Exit 113 SB on-ramp closed from 9 PM to 5 AM. Motorists will be advised to use Exit 109 or Exit 112.
Tues. 9/17	Exit 113 SB off-ramp closed from 7 PM to 5 AM. Motorists will be advised to use Exit 109 or Exit 112.
Wed. 9/18	Route 27 reduced to a single lane of alternating one-way traffic from 6:30 PM to 5:30 AM.
Thurs. 9/19	Route 27 reduced to a single lane of alternating one-way traffic from 6:30 PM to 5:30 AM.
Fri. 9/20	Route 27 reduced to a single lane of alternating one-way traffic from 6:30 PM to 5:30 AM.

The Exit 113 Improvements will improve traffic flow and safety for those traveling westerly on Route 3, intersecting between Old Belgrade Road and Route 27, as well as those going to the new regional hospital. The project is expected to be completed in November.
