I take the boldness to writ
you a few lines concerning
some back State Aid which
My Family is now

Suffering for to get their
subsistence I insisted
June 20 1862 Stat Aid
was applied for in July 1862
received 5 dollars in August
received 3 dollars did not
receive any more untill July
1863 In which time they
disposed of all the female
Mones which I left them
If you could assist them you
would do me a great
kindness as well as them
It is hard to be away from
a home & Family but

Harder to know that they are
suffering I send all my
own earnings home but that
I do not strive for them as
things is very high Flour
Is 12 dollars per barrel
My Family is living
In Fremont Plantation
