Camp Fependen Va by reason of Surgeons  
Certificate of Disability - (No objection to his  
being re-enlisted is known to exist) -  
Said Jason Carver was born in Leeds  
in the State of Maine is Forty Three years  
of age 5 feet 11 inches high, Light complexion  
Blue Eyes Sandy Hair and by occupation  
when Enrolled a Farmer -

Given at Camp Fependen this  
18<sup>th</sup> day of September 1861
