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22. At the request of the Governor of Maine, Private *John W. Hubbard*, Company "G," 1st Maine Heavy Artillery, is hereby honorably discharged the service of the United States, to enable him to accept a commission as 2d Lieutenant, with condition that, if not mustered in as an officer under the same, he shall return to his former company, or be considered a deserter.

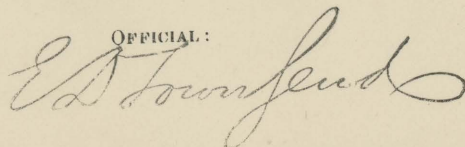
