AGRICULTURE AND TRUSTS.

The Hon. Aaron Jones of Indiana,

master of the National Grange, in his

remarks before the "Oxford Farmer," held in

Chicago, said in part:

"Every citizen of this republic should

be free to use his labor as he will best

contribute to his benefit and happiness, not

however, infringing on the rights of any

other citizen."

"The right to acquire, own, control

and enjoy the use and income of property,

is an inalienable right that should be

protected by the Government. Government

is organized and laws are enacted

to better protect life, liberty and the

ownership and use of property. It is

the duty of the Government to protect

the rights of its citizens in the full and

free enjoyment of these rights. It is for

this purpose that the Government is

organized and laws are enacted to

"The tendency of the times is for

conducting large business enterprises and

concentration of business into the hands

of a few. In the early history of this

country, when individuals desired to do

a more extended business than they had

capital to control, partnerships were

formed, and the business was conducted

jointly. These partnerships gave them no

additional powers or privileges beyond

those enjoyed by the individual citizen."

"As the demand came for concentration

of business on a still greater scale,

the law was enacted to permit the

formation of corporations to conduct certain

classes of business, and with certain

privileges and powers. These corporations

were organized for the purpose of buying

and conducting them all under one

management, and it has been found

that the more consolidated corporations or

trusts, as they are commonly known,

the more they have infringed on the rights

of individuals, and in some instances

operated in restraint of trade, being

detrimental to the rights of labor, and
