11. Private *Elijah Hodgkins*, Company "C," 2d Maine Volunteers, a deserter, now in the hands of the Provost Marshal, in this city, is hereby restored to duty, without trial, upon the condition that he makes good the time lost by desertion.

The 2d Maine Volunteers, having been mustered out of the service, he is assigned for duty to the 20th Maine Volunteers.
