an oath deposed to & sworn in the army
the most of the time during the Revolutionary
war & their became a quainter with Daniel
Kinsley now resident of Minot in the County
and State of aforesaid he belonged to Capt
Mehat Jacksons Regiment he was one of the
last three years men I was intonally acquainted
with him and we were often on duty together
I was discharged I think the tenth of June Seventeen
hundred & eighty three I left said Kinsley in
the Service
