up to the battle of Fredericksburg when he was severely
wounded & taken prisoner - He has been exchanged,
recovered from his wounds and illness & is about to return
to the service. We learn from his associates in the army
that he has served with marked ability, and we believe that
no more suitable or better deserved appointment could be
made than that of Mr. Keaminy to the place which is
herein sought for him.
