

Frederick Md November 5. 1862

General

I have sent you the Roll of my Co. corrected in accordance with your directions. My Company are somewhat scattered, one or two men not present, for whom I have received as yet no Discipline Roll, do not know whether they are married or single.

Since I had the report nearly completed, we learned that the new appointments as Capt & Lieuts are invalid. We have received no order in regard to the matter since we were ordered to muster them as Lieuts, so I have let it remain.

I never received any official intimation of several discharges - among others that of Dr Howard now Asst Surgeon in the 10th Regt Inf'ts - so could not give exact details. As we have been very busy getting ready our Pay Rolls could not get this Roll ready quite so soon as you desire but send it at the earliest possible moment compatible with other duties I am General
