Dear General

Colonel Allen has just informed me that you have not received the annual return of my company, - The first day of the month I was in Washington & on my return to this place, found the Regiment had received orders & left;

Being unable to fill up the form without the records of the Morning Report Book, I at once sent the blank to Lt. Spurling, who is in command of the company, with particular instructions to attend to the matter immediately. I have every reason to suppose that you will be in possession of the return before receiving this; but to insure against further delay, I will write to the Lt. again to day in reference to it;

I have been detached from the Regiment since the 13<sup>th</sup> of Sept. -
