Dear Sir

at your request I write you
a few lines to let you know
that my descriptive list has
not come the soldiers here
were paid off yesterday but
I could not receive any pay
because I had not got any
descriptive list I dont know
but they are going to discharge
me they examined me a little the
other day if they discharge
me they will have to get a
descriptive list some where
and I dont see why they dont
discharge me for I am no
good in the service only for
doctors to practice upon my
time expires the second day
of next may so if it is the
lords will I shall be permit^{ed}
to return to my home and

there will be one years pay
due me when this month is out
there was 4 months due me
when I left the regiment and
I have got 4 months since. I
got 2 months of the paymaster
at Washington and they paid
me 2 months at the hosp^{ts}
at west Philadelphia
