feeling very anxious in relation to the
appointment of Major of that Regt,

free and is fearing that - thus while
he is held a prisoner may make an
effort to have the vacancy filled before
he gets released

If it is not absolutely
necessary to have the appointment made
at present, and you will defer it, you
will confer a great favor upon my Son,
and those who are interested for him,
