In Council, January 24. 1822.

The Military Committee to whom was referred the petitions of Gideon Robinson, Junior, and others of Freedom and the adjacent towns, in the fourth Regiment, Second Brigade and fourth Division, praying, "that they may be organized into a company of Light Infantry" by the name of the "Freedom Light Infantry," ask leave to Report, that said petition is approved by the commanding officers of said Regiment and Brigade; and that for the reasons stated in said petition it is the opinion of the Committee, that the prayer of the same ought to be granted, and that said company be attached to the aforesaid fourth Regiment. And the Governor and Commander in Chief is advised to cause an order to be issued organizing and attaching said company accordingly.
