**7:00 p.m. – CALL TO ORDER**

Attendance: Chairman Moriarty, Councilors Copp, Storey-King, Turner, Stiles, and Porter.  
Excused: Councilor Damon

**I. RECOGNITION CEREMONY FOR CHIEF DANIEL SMALL**

Chairman Moriarty acknowledged Chief Small's parents Carolyn and George Small, his wife, Tricia. Also in attendance were 27 members of the Cumberland Fire Department. The Chair introduced Portland Fire Chief Fred Lamontagne, who shared "As an individual who has enrolled in the Executive Fire Officer Program and completed but one module to date, I am well aware of the personal sacrifice and professional commitment required to complete the program. You should know that Dan is joined in an elite group of men and women in our nation. He is one of the few who can honestly say that their work has a direct impact on the safety of firefighters nationally. His papers are on file at the library at the National Fire Academy where other fire service leaders like myself may read and take guidance from his research, ideas, and outcomes. The designation infers without question leadership, dedication, commitment, and perseverance - all traits that great leaders possess. It says that Dan is one of the top leaders in our nation. It says that Dan is successful in completing one of the most arduous and challenging management programs in the country; where the classes carry the weight of equivalency of Masters' programs. It states without question for the town, the state, and the nation what we all knew: That Dan Small is one of the great leaders in our Fire Service." Chief Lamontagne introduced Captain Don Rawnsley who offered congratulations and accolades on behalf of the Cumberland Fire Department. "I and other members of the Cumberland Fire Department are here tonight to honor Chief Dan Small for his accomplishments; not only for leading the Cumberland Fire Department, but for the completion of The National Fire Academy Program. The Department has made great strides under Chief Small's leadership. He has very high standards and goals for the Department and himself."

Chairman Moriarty presented Chief Small with the certificate which conferred the "title of Executive Fire Officer upon Daniel Ray Small with all honors, privileges, and responsibilities, thereunto appertaining, awarded August 25, 2006." In accepting the award, Chief Small stated "I just want to thank the troops here. You can see the support for the organization; from my family as well. This is a wonderful commitment to have behind me now, but the lessons learned will hopefully be around a long time to come. Our manager and council have been very supportive of the Department. I can't thank you enough to everybody for filling in for me while I was gone and supporting me in this project. Thank you very much."

**II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

March 12, 2007

Motion by Councilor Turner; seconded by Councilor Storey-King, to approve the minutes as presented.

### **III. MANAGER'S REPORT**

- Darrell Plummer – co-owner of 56 Forest Lake Road property addressed the council. Mr. Plummer thanked the town council and manager for their time regarding their interest in purchasing his family's property at 56 Forest Lake. "The proposed boat launch is intended for boats, not swimming or sunbathing. What better neighbor could Forest Lake residents have than the town, who will utilize resources of the State of Maine to improve the lake?" Upon the town's expressed interest, he instinctively considered his parents and what they may have thought about a boat launch on their property. "As I thought about it, I remembered what people said about them; how kind and generous they were. This led me to believe that they would approve of the launch that would let people enjoy the lake for generations to come." He further felt it important "to rebut" statements made at a previous public hearing. "Because of all the allegations made...I am now forced to share private family information with you all," explaining the family purchased two memory stones in honor of his parents; a stone was placed at the Cornish Cemetery and the second was meant for placement on his sister's property, located next door to his parent's property. Upon his sister's passing shortly thereafter, he "brought the stone to my brother's, where it is kept in memory of my parents. There are no bodies or anything else buried on our property at Forest Lake. In closing, I hope that when all the dust settles...if the launch does not go through, that I will be able to undo all of the damage done by those with a personal agenda. I hope that the town does prevail so all Cumberland residents may enjoy the lake."
- Update re: Skillins & Blanchard Road Construction: The Manager stated the town will be completing road improvements from Skillins Road to Blanchard Road. Much blasting has occurred to install a waterline. "I did not feel it appropriate to leave that road in the state it is in presently, and I don't think it can really make it through another winter."

### **IV. PUBLIC DISCUSSION**

Nancy Heyner, 66 Forest Lake Road, responded to the issue of statements made at the prior public hearing. "I apologize for the use of 'headstone' if it was a memory stone. I'm here to let you, the town council, and the citizens of Cumberland know that I am not a liar. I am a trained hospice volunteer. I am very familiar with the dying process, death and the associated mourning and grief that a family member will deal with after the loss of a loved one. I would never use someone's grief to try to muddy up any issue and to insinuate that to me is quite insulting." She stressed her position at the earlier meeting was that a council vote should have been tabled upon hearing information regarding a memory stone. Chairman Moriarty clarified "The question was whether it was a gravesite. When others said...there were human remains interred on the property, that was not true." Councilor Turner added "some of those statements were patently false. It's unfortunate that the subject ever even came up." Councilor Porter suggested "A political hammer was used and in the process a family was hurt." The Manager expressed his belief that Mrs. Heyner "brought it back to civility quite honestly." Councilor Storey-King appreciated the clarification, adding "A prior speaker said that there were remains on the property. The implication that a gravestone would be removed was appalling to me." Councilor Copp concluded, "I believe there are some individuals on Forest Lake that owe him (Mr. Plummer) an apology."

### **V. LEGISLATION AND POLICY**

- 07 – 035. To hold public hearing to consider and act upon funding and improvements for the Twin Brook shelter and maintenance project and to proceed with Planning Board and DEP construction documents and approvals.**

Chairman Moriarty explained the shelter and maintenance proposal has been "in the works for quite some time." The council held a workshop January 29, 2007, and the committee has accomplished much analysis and planning since the last workshop. In attendance were Recreation Director, Bill Landis, and committee members John Andrews, Kate Fowler, John Eldredge, John Stroud, Peter Gordon and Glenn Hutchins. Committee chair, John Andrews, deferred to the manager to address financing. A TIF was authorized in



March 1996, with 25% of the tax dollars dedicated to the development of the Twin Brook site. The TIF will expire in June 2027 if not phased out by the town council at an earlier date. "We are one of the last communities with a recreation TIF in the State. If the money was not sheltered, these monies would be lost in reduced state aid." The council authorized a \$1.1 million bond in June, 2006, for these improvements, and the bond will be repaid entirely by TIF dollars.

Mr. Andrews explained the committee's goal to increase the safety and convenience of users; improve existing multi-purpose playing fields; avoid negative impact on open space views and existing activities; protect equipment; and reduce visual impact. Secondary goals include bringing users further back into the park and reducing the tendency to speed along the "straight away."

The committee recommendations included four components: improve playing field on the back hill (hill-side field); add a storage/maintenance building in the woods; revise traffic pattern and back parking lot; and add the field shelter with restrooms, concession area, utilities and storage. "These items are inter-related and each is a component to achieve the overall stated goals." Councilor Shirley Storey-King questioned the parking space. There is no reduction in parking space; "We will actually be picking up parking places" to alleviate parking on the front access road. The maintenance building will replace the existing storage trailer and protect valuable equipment and allow for on-site repairs. The traffic pattern will be revised to reconfigure the back parking lot. The field shelter will serve as a central pick-up and drop-off location and a safe haven from weather. Port-a-potties will be replaced by bathrooms within the shelter, which also houses a contained concession area. "The intent is to make it as barn-like as possible to fit into the surrounding area." A budget figure was provided at \$1,095,200, with the breakdown as follows: playing field on the hill - \$200,000; parking lot improvements - \$75,000; road re-alignment - \$45,000; 40x60' maintenance building - \$240,000; concession shelter/bathrooms - \$288,000; 15% contingency for engineering - \$120,000; and an overall 15% contingency - \$127,200. A project timeline of February, 2007 through June, 2008 was given, with construction completion anticipated for June, 2008.

Sevee and Mahar Engineer, John Kennedy, presented visuals of the site showing the placement of the field, road reconfiguration and structures. Traffic counts "clearly put us into the MDOT permit requirement." The state has requested a short taper and right turn lane to allow the heavier movement, advisory signage, and a street light "attached to a pole." Slight shoulder paving must be done at the Greeley Road entrance. "DEP has encouraged us to do avoidance and minimization of the trail system first" by looking to move or discontinue trails. This amounts to a discontinuance of 7,300 feet of trails and a relocation of approximately 4,300 feet of trails. A new trail connecting to the Dillenbach property would reduce the impact to 31,000 square feet. Therefore, "compensation" is needed.

A paved area around the maintenance building is needed for circulation purposes. The new playing field and shelter will be located across the roadway from the maintenance building. A new parking lot will be constructed, with approximately 110 spaces (65 spaces currently). The realignment of the road will include restoration of some wetland and will serve to control traffic speeds. The shelter height is 23.5 feet to the peak with a 7 foot cupola. A new trail connection between the football and baseball fields is proposed. Drainage improvements will be made along the edge of the football field by installing a storm drain.

Chairman Moriarty asked about the eliminated trail and whether the discontinuance breaks the cross country course. Mr. Kennedy replied "there are extensive wetlands there. It's a matter of mowing. We can create a mowed trail outside the wetlands," and Chairman Moriarty suggested informing the Greeley coaches.

Sarah Russell, Tuttle Road, directly across from Twin Brook, stated that while she is "in support of the shelter" she has concerns related to the negative impact on open space, "and not just the views themselves." She believes a concession stand will increase staff; toilets and building will increase lighting. She presented several questions related to a street light, closing of the park, need for increased maintenance, future use by dogs, and use of environmental building materials and fixtures. "What's gonna prevent us from putting stands

in the fields? I'm wondering if there are any checks and balances? Where does it stop? I am concerned about not thinking about the future."

Chairman Moriarty responded that the current dog use policy will remain in effect. The park is not intended to be open at night. Mr. Andrews added that the committee discussed the "greening of the facility." The only lights will be inside the bathrooms; there is no consideration at present for lights or bleachers. The concession stand will service events and the trash management will be addressed as part of that. "We're not trying to bring any more users there." Councilor Porter clarified "There's a pretty unanimous view amongst us that are currently on the council," but "there are no prohibitions written into the deed." The Manager explained a conservation easement will be placed by the DEP. Development outside the trail networks will be extremely difficult if not impossible. "There are not a lot of pieces left that could be developed."

Committee member Glenn Hutchins expressed his opposition to lights or bleachers. He feels strongly an all-purpose field at the high school would alleviate some of the use on Twin Brook. "That's where the lights should be." Bob Heyner, Forest Lake Road, asked about refreshing of the fields. Recreation Director, Bill Landis, responded that the town must shut each field down for a period of time to revitalize it. There's an ever growing need for fields in Cumberland. Keeping to a single use on the field "does help to keep that field playable for years to come."

Councilor Stiles noted the shower shown in the maintenance building is needed for town employees who work with pesticides. The public hearing closed at 8:50 p.m.

"I think it's gonna look nice" added Councilor Porter. "I am not a fan of lights" and if the hours of use continue as they are, "there's no need for those lights." He complimented the committee, the engineer and the manager. Councilor Copp does not "see any need for these street lights...I think it would be a hindrance to the neighbors to have to look at a light." The Manager responded there are cross country skiers who use the facility after the gates are closed. "Because of the vehicle traffic on that site" the DOT made this recommendation, he explained; however, "We will explain this is a day time facility only. Hopefully, we can just illuminate the intersection. "We'll see if we can get that removed."

Motion by Councilor Porter; seconded by Councilor Stiles, to authorize the Town Manager to proceed with Planning Board and DEP approvals and to develop bid documents for the improvements at the Twin Brook Recreation Area.

VOTE: UNANIMOUS PASSAGE 6-0

**07 – 036. To hold public hearing to consider and act on a wharf application by Katherine Pope for additional floats at 19 Sturdivant Road, Map U05, Lot 7D.**

Town Manager Shane introduced Bub Fournier, Custom Floats, representing the Pope Family. Input from the residents of Foreside and Wildwood were received. Affirmative action this evening allows the applicant to proceed to the Planning Board for a Shoreland Review permit.

The Coastal Waters Commission agreed to support the application with the following conditions:

1. The floats shall be anchored such that there is 10' from the end of the inland float to the high water mark at all times.
2. The winter storage of the floats shall not be stored on sea grass.
3. The winter storage of floats shall use the helix anchor system (presently used on the shore side to anchor the floats) for the winter and no danforth anchors shall be used.
4. An additional set of helix anchors shall be placed at the end of the new floats as presented by Custom Float on March 25, 2007.

No public comments were received. Motion by Councilor Porter; seconded by Councilor Turner, to approve the "wharfing out" application by Katherine Pope for 40 feet of additional floats at 19 Sturdivant Road, Map

U05, Lot 7D, pursuant to the conditions recommended by the Coastal Waters Commission at its March 15, 2007 public hearing.

VOTE: UNANIMOUS PASSAGE 6-0

**07 – 037. To issue a license for the location of a temporary office trailer for the Chebeague Island Boatyard within the town right-of-way for John Small Road. *TABLED INDEFINITELY***

The Manager explained the applicant's engineer presented a stamped survey to the town, making a license unnecessary.

Motion by Councilor Stiles; seconded by Councilor Turner; to table indefinitely.

**07 – 038. To hear summary report from Chairman Moriarty, liaison to the Route 100 Advisory Committee, re: zoning changes proposed for Route 100, and to set a 6:00 p.m. Workshop with the Route 100 Advisory Committee and Planning Board, Tuesday, April 10, 2007, Val Halla Banquet Center.**

The Chair provided a history of the committee's work. The committee hopes to wrap up their work next Thursday and a joint Council/Planning Board workshop held April 10, 2007, at Val Halla, followed by a town council meeting on April 23, 2007. The committee is proposing to create "five new zones." The first, Village Commercial, would take the place of the highway commercial zone; the most intense of the various zones, allowing a variety of uses including banks, professional offices, 25,000 sq ft retail footprints, and certain special exceptions. The Village Office Commercial Zone will be located at each end of the VC Zone. It allows slightly less intensive uses providing for professional offices and banks, but no retail outlets or grocery stores. The Village OC II zone is nearly identical to the VOC except single family dwellings will be permitted as a special exception. The Mixed Use Zone allows retail and grocery space. The fifth zone is an enlargement of the existing medium density residential zone to allow for more residential uses on somewhat smaller lots and in keeping with the "village" concept for the center area. The proposed zoning maps are on the town website at this time for public view. He encouraged the Planning Board to consider special meetings to accelerate the process. When the town council takes action on the proposed zoning changes, the effective date may be retroactive to March 26, 2007.

Motion by Councilor Copp; seconded by Councilor Storey-King, to set a Workshop 6:00 p.m., Tuesday, April 10, 2007, with the Planning Board and Route 100 Advisory Committee to discuss proposed zoning map, districts, uses and design guidelines for the Route 100 corridor.

VOTE: UNANIMOUS PASSAGE 6-0

**VI. NEW BUSINESS**

**Councilor Copp** – Skillins Road work underway; "try to take a detour".

**Councilor Storey-King** – has been asked to remind the public that access to Val Halla is via Val Halla Road off of Greely Road; please avoid speeding through the neighborhood on the way to Val Halla events.

**Councilor Turner** – support of bike paths off Route 88; asked about status of potential paths.

**Councilor Stiles** – wanted to thank everyone for the sympathy shown after his father's passing.

**Councilor Porter** – concerned about a Portland Press Herald story about York growth cap; state law requires towns must reset their growth caps every three years based at 105% of the average number of permits over a ten year period – requested Manager to get a clarification.

- **Request for Workshop with Gray and Windham Town Council, 7:00 p.m., Monday, April 2, 2007, Val Halla Banquet Center, re: purchase of 56 Forest Lake.**

**Town Manager Shane** – requested the council schedule a workshop for Monday, April 2, 2007, 7pm at Val Halla Banquet Center, to meet with the Gray and Windham Town Council regarding the Forest Lake purchase.

Councilor Copp made a motion to set a workshop date for Monday at 7pm at Val Halla with Gray and Windham Town Councils. This would be a public meeting in which the public will be provided an opportunity to participate if time allows.  
Councilor Turner seconded the motion.

VOTE: UNANIMOUS PASSAGE 6-0

The Town Manager reviewed items requiring council consideration and action.

Appoint a Route 88 Pedestrian Access Committee. Councilor Turner moved that the town council resolve to appoint a committee to look into pedestrian use on Route 88; Councilor Storey-King seconded. Councilor Porter added “Foreside neighbors, council liaison; and other interested citizens.”

VOTE: UNANIMOUS PASSAGE 6-0

Doane Property Development Committee – 40 acres behind the Public Works garage; a multi-use facility, including professional and senior/affordable housing. This is a fairly significant project in scope. The initial charge still needs to be developed. A seven member committee is recommended as workable. Chair requested a workshop with survey results circulated ahead of time.

Forest Lake Subcommittee – similar to other Facility Use Policy committees. IF & W will be utilized as a technical consultant. Councilors discussed timing for petition circulation and subsequent election as it related to the creation of a committee.

Councilor Turner moved to advertise for applicants at this time to form a committee to look into appropriate uses for Forest Lake Property; Councilor Porter seconded the motion.

VOTE: UNANIMOUS PASSAGE 6-0

The Manager proposed forming a Range Road Reconstruction committee. We are addressing the water line as part of the master loop to provide fire protection to a great majority of our community. We would be using TIF dollars to address blind spots, shoulder work, and safety conditions. He recommended to advertise soon and include a member of the Rines Forest Committee. Chair suggested that it would be a good idea to add this proposal to the workshop agenda. Councilor Porter cautioned not to “bite off too much too quick.”

7:00 p.m. – Call to Order

Attendance: Chairman Moriarty, Councilors Copp, Storey-King, Turner, Stiles, and Cumberland Town Manager William R. Shane.

Guests: Town of Gray – Chairman Gary Foster, Councilors M. Skip Crane, Andrew Upham, and Town Manager Deborah Cabana. Town of Windham – Chairman John MacKinnon, Councilors Carol Waig, Michael Shaugnessy, Lloyd Bennett, Bob Muir, Liz Wisecup, and Town Manager Tony Plante.

Chairman Moriarty called the workshop to order by introducing and thanking the elected guests from Windham and Gray for their attendance. The Chairman began by providing the chronological history leading up to the council vote to purchase the 56 Forest Lake property. He explained the council's vote to purchase is subject to an override vote, and the question will likely be before the Cumberland voters in June if the current petition effort is successful. The chair also stated the town does not have specific defined plans for the property at this time and intends to form a citizens' advisory committee to review and consider the issues associated with the use of the property, as it has done with previous land purchases such as Twin Brook and the Rines property.

The chair then opened the meeting to the officials of the attending towns. Statements and questions centered predominantly on the need for a policy regarding the type and size of watercraft using the launch site. Other comments were made regarding milfoil, safety, noise, pollution, enforcement, parking, bathroom facilities, and water quality. Some Windham councilors suggested a decision and even policy regarding use should be established prior to a referendum vote.

The chair opened the meeting to attendees from the public who reiterated similar comments and concerns as those shared by the officials of Gray and Windham. Speakers included Genevieve Levin, Gray; Lorrayne Mastrangelo, Gray; Janene Gorham, Cumberland; Kat Wallingford, Cumberland; Denise Tanguay, Windham; Paula Curcio, Gray; Jim Maris, Gray; Bob Heyner, Cumberland; Tina Leblanc, Windham; Bill McFarland, Cumberland; Marie Daggett, Cumberland; Dave Russell, Cumberland; Shawn Carter, Cumberland; Larry Blair; Joe Early; Ted Chadbourne, Cumberland; Bob Simonds, Cumberland; Joe Radziszewski, Gray; Nancy Heyner, Cumberland; and Terri Russell, Cumberland. Speaking in support of the purchase were Bob Mahoney, Cumberland; Mike Perfetti, Cumberland; Bill McFarland, Cumberland; and Mark Robinson, Cumberland.

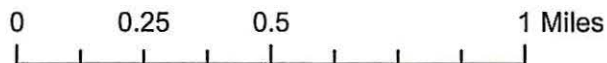
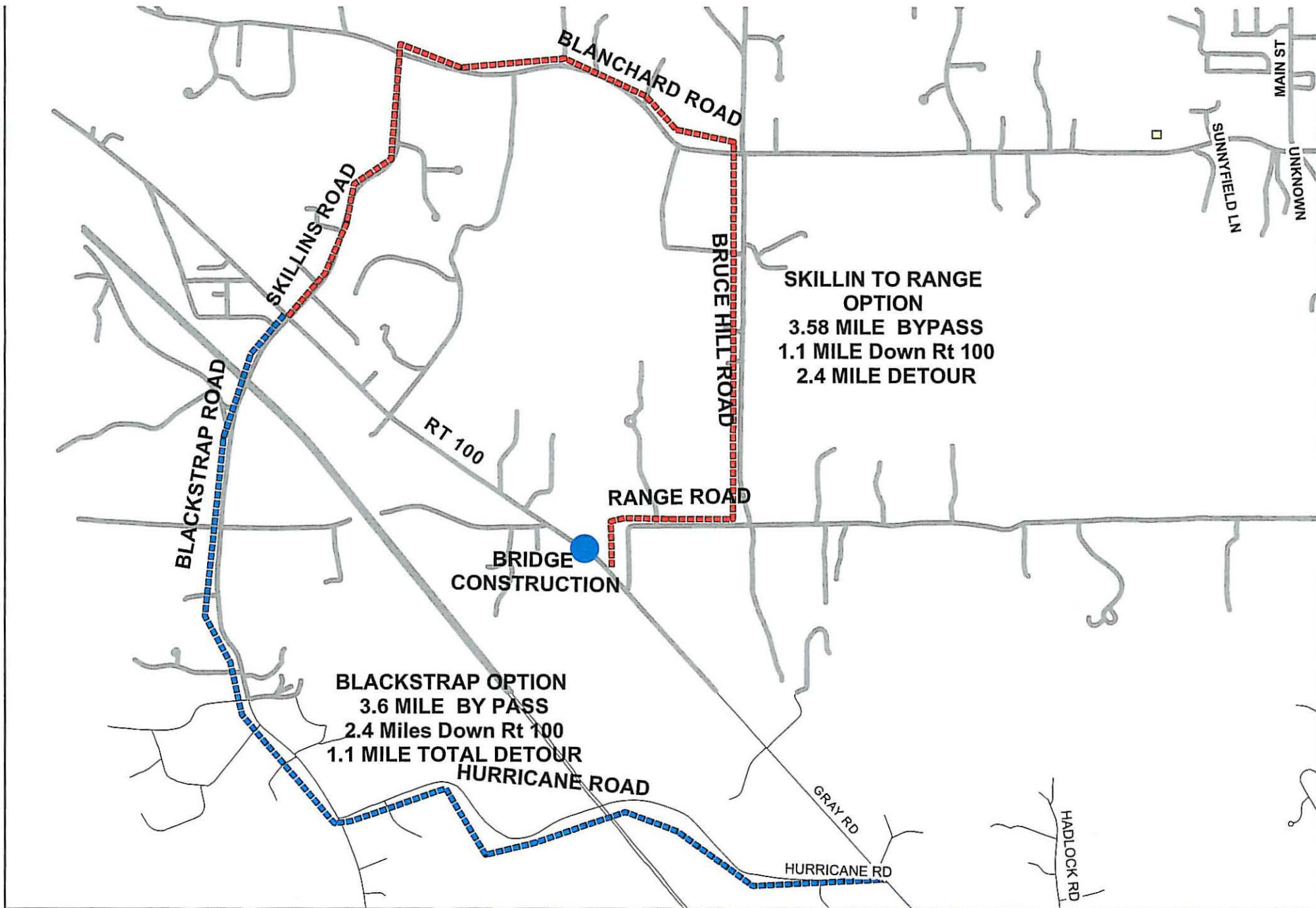
