within and for said County of Oxford on the second Tuesday of June A.D.
1839

And now in this term of the Court, the Commissioners on examining
the within account of Sewall Brackett under keeper of the State Gaol in Paris
in the County of Oxford on oath exhibited do find that the charges for sup-
port of Prisoners in said gaol unable to support themselves committed by
due process of law upon charge & conviction of crimes against the State
and therein confined from the second day of October 1838 to the thirteenth
day of February 1839 amount to the sum of fourteen dollars & forty two
cents & that said prisoners have not been able to pay any part thereof;
therefore said sum has been allowed & ordered by the Court to be paid
out of the Treasury of this County & charged to the State agreeably to the
Statute in such case made & provided.
