within & for said County, of Oxford on the last Tuesday of October A.D. 1839
And now in this term of the Court on examining the within account of
E. C. Shaw under keeper of the State's Jail in Paris in the County of Oxford on
oath exhibited, the Court do find, that the charges for support of prisoners
in said Jail unable to support themselves, committed by due process of
law, upon charge or conviction of crimes against the State & therein con-
fined from the eighteenth day of June A.D. 1839 amount to the sum
of twenty four dollars and eighty six cents & that said prisoners have not
been able to pay any part thereof; therefore said sum has been allowed
and ordered by the Court to be paid out of the Treasury of this County
and charged to the State agreeably to the Statute in such case made
and provided
