3. Private *John A. Quinn*, Company "B," 1st Regiment Invalid Corps, to Company "D," 4th Maine Volunteers.

Private *Michael Butler*, Company "K," 1st Regiment Invalid Corps, to Company "F," 4th Maine Volunteers.

The Quartermaster's Department will furnish the necessary transportation.


