Dear Sir

Since the enclosed recommendation for George C. Drummond, to receive a Lieut's Commission, ^{was written} I have communicated with him, in regard to a vacancy, and as he said, there was none in his regiment, that would be likely to be filled, until the regiment was filled up. I have deferred sending the recommendation to you until the present time.

I now forward it, with the hope that he may receive, what a true & heroic soldier is ever entitled, when there is an opportunity, promotion.

I learn by his Captain, Mc Intire, that he is now acting Orderly Sergeant.

He also expressed the wish that he might be promoted - Capt-Mc Intire is now in Augusta.
