Vols, has been at all times a faithful and efficient coldier in this ca-hacity, that he is thoroughly acquanited with the business pertaining to the Quarter-master's Department of his Regiment, and it would but meet the hearty approbation of all concerned, Officers and men, to learn of his fromation to Quartermaster. Since my absence from the Regiment and before being mustered out of it, I lever Stevens was detailed as acting a. m., but at the same time he did not nor was it expected of him to use his own judgment in matter relating to the Department, and it is only fait to say for the weeface of the Regiment that Lieut. Stevens is not a suitable person for their anartemaster.

Having been asked for a caudid de claration of my sentiments, have witten the above, free from personal prejudice, but anying that a proper person may receive the appointment of Quartermaster.
