I have the honor in common with the friends of Sergeant Luallen Lincoln of this Regiment, in presenting his claims for promotion in one of the Regiments now being organized in the State. I would call your attention to his qualifications and valuable services performed.

Sergeant Lincoln joined the Regiment at its original organization and has participated in all the various duties the Regiment has been called upon to perform. He has been engaged in all the Battles except 1st Bulls Run; at that time he was on duty as guard to the Train. He was severely wounded Dec. 13. 1862, at the Battle of Fredericksburg, and promptly joined the Regiment before he had fully recovered. He is a young man of good habits, possessing a constitution to endure the hardships incident to an
