Bangor Nov 2 1863.

Dear Gov.

in his Co. K. and I learn there are
two vacancies in the Co. of Lieuts - The
friends of Mr S. are very desirous he
shall be promoted to Lieut, and I sincerely
hope you will apt him - and I cheerfully
recommend him to your favorable consideration.
