I respectfully
ask information concerning the
expiration of my term of service.
I was a member of Co "B" of the
2^d Regt. Maine Regt and was trans-
ferred to the Twentieth. I was
mustered into the service at
Bangor. July 4th 1861. but the books
of this regt. show that I was mus-
tered Aug. 31st 1861. If I can-
not prove the date to be wrong
I shall be retained two months
nearly over my time. There
are a number of men in the
regiment who enlisted and

were mustered into the service
with me, ^{but} the books show
that they were mustered July
4th which is correct. There has
evidently been an error com-
mitted and my object in
writing you was to learn
if the rolls in your office
gave the date of my muster
as July 4th or Aug. 31st 1861.
I have requested my company
commander to look it up but
he has neglected to do so. I am
now a member of Co "H."
