In Council June 23<sup>d</sup> - 1840.

The Standing Committee on military affairs to which was referred the petition of Shepard Bean and others in the town of Lee, within the limits of the sixth Regiment, first Brigade and third Division, praying that they may be organized into a Company of Light Infantry, having examined the case, Report that the petition is approved by the commanding officers of said Regiment, Brigade and Division, and in their opinion the prayer of the petitioners ought to be granted. They therefore recommend that the Governor and Commander in Chief be advised to cause an order to issue whereby the petitioners shall be organized into a Company of Light Infantry and attached to said Regiment with authority to enlist members within the limits thereof.
