Sir: I received by mail last evening Commission for Capt, Claim S. Daggett as Major of this Regiment. I must say that I felt not a little surprised at the appointment. Occaring to all precedents, recommendations for Field Officers, have been made by the commanders of Brigades; and their opin appointment. I cannot understand why this wile has been set aside, in this case, for all must admit, that the commanding officer is the best judge of the merits and qualifications of the Officers in his Command. One case of this sind in this Regiment proves the truth of this assertion I refer to the Appointment of Mm & noyes as Asst Surgeon which appointment was made without the recommendation of the Meedical men, or either the Commanding officer of the Regiment or Longade. He was manifestly incompetent for the position and was therefore compelled

I can make no more a commendations for promotion or appointment until I understand whether they are to be made on recommendation of persons outside this command, on personal application or otherwise I do not wish it to be understood that I have any personal feeling against the ap-pointment of Capit. Daggett. The case was referred by me to general Burtlett Commanding the Dougade, and the interests of the service only were tusten in consideration The fact that bapt. Daggett mus absent from his Regiment sifteen days without leave when the troops were under marching orders Euranot be over looved, and his promotion inmedically thereafter, tends to countenance the One reason why Capitain Stevens was recommended for the position, was that he was unable to do duty as a foot Officer on account of wounds received in actions and would be compelled to leave the service unless promoted to the position of a mounted officed Will you please inform me by telurn mail what course will be pursued in relation to the el commendations which have been formander, as the appointment of bapt Duggett as mujor mel nocessarily again some Changes to be
