Chapter 217 known as the Used Car Information Law shall be discontinued effective upon the signing of this document:

1. Failing to provide a purchaser with the written statement of the warranty as required by Title 10 M.R.S.A.

§ 1474;

2. Failing to disclose the information required by

§ 1475; and

3. Otherwise failing to comply with Title 10 M.R.S.A. Chapter 217.

In addition, Copp Motors, Inc. hereby agrees:


A. To provide those persons who have purchased vehicles from Copp Motors after December 31, 1977, to date and who were


