rest of his rest.

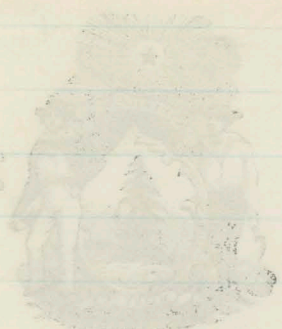
