The Military Committee to whom was referred the petitions of Thomas Milburn and others of the second Brigade in the sixth Division, praying that they may be organized into a company of Cavalry, ask leave to Report. That said petition is approved by the commanding Officers of said Brigade and Division, and that for the reasons stated in said petition, it is the opinion of the Committee that the prayer of the same ought to be granted; and that a company of Cavalry be raised in said Brigade ~~and attached to the same~~. And the Governor and Commander in Chief is advised to cause an order to be issued organizing ~~and attaching~~ said company accordingly.
