SPECIAL TOWN MEETING HELD-- JANUARY 26, 1948

Article 1- To choose a Moderator to preside at said meeting.

Gilbert Michaud was elected Moderator

by majority of votes. He was sworn in by Town Clerk.

Article 2- To see if the Town will vote to join with the following Town and Plantations, namely: Fort Kent, Wallagrass Plantation, New Canada Plantation, Winterville Plantation, St. John Plantation, St. Francis Plantation, and Allagash Plantation, to form a Secondary School District to be known as a "Community School District".

The vote on this article was:

In favor -One hundred and one (101) yes

Against- Fifty eight (58) no

Article 3--

To see if the Town will vote that the district be authorized to acquire and hold property of a value not in excess of \$150,000.00.

The vote on this article was--

In favor -- Ninety- eight (98) yes

Against---- Twenty- two (22) no

Article 4-- To see if the Town will to authorize said Community School District from time to time to borrow money and to ~~issue~~ its bonds and notes therefor in an amount not in excess of \$150,000.00 for the purpose of constructing and equipping a community school building and other purposes of the district.

On this article--

Unanimous vote- Ballot cast.

Article- 5- To transact any other business that may legally be brought before said meeting.

Voted to adjourn meeting.
