In Council, January 25. 1822

The Military Committee to whom was referred the petition of Ephraim Kimball and others, of the town of Hiram in the second Regiment, second Brigade and sixth Division, praying that they may be organized into a company of Light Infantry by the name of the "Hiram Light-Infantry" asks leave to Report, That said petition is approved by the Major General of said Division; and that for the reasons stated in said petition, it is the opinion of the Committee that a company of Light-Infantry ought to be raised and organized in said town of Hiram, and attached to the aforesaid second Regiment. And the Governor and Commander in Chief is advised to cause an order to be issued organizing and attaching said company accordingly.
