Sir;

I have the honor of respectfully forwarding, accompanying, a list of recommendations for promotions in this regiment. While I have made recommendations for Second Lieutenants, there is but one company (Co. "7") which has a sufficient number of men to allow the muster of such an officer under existing orders. But if consistent, I would be pleased to have commissions issued to the remaining three persons, as it is desirable that they may act in such positions - a number of my officers being absent upon "detached service", and also that they may be duly mustered at the proper period. But in case this does not meet your approval, I would most respectfully request that the commissions for Captains

and 47 inst Lieutenants may be forwarded
as soon as convenient.

There is a vacancy in Co. "A" arising
from the capture and imprisonment and
subsequent dishonorable discharge of Captain
Pillsbury. But I entertain no doubt that he
will be honorably reinstated to his command
upon his release by the enemy: I have made
no recommendation to fill this vacancy in
anticipation of such an event.
