We were informed a few days ^{since} that the
name of Alvin or Albion Stroman who went from
this Town as a volunteer in Co. D. 5th Maine Reg. had
been dropped from the rolls - will you have the
kindness to inform us when, or for what cause
his name was thus dropped, as we have been paying
his mother State aid up to the first of this month.
The latest information previous to this, we had
from him was, that he was in ^{the} Hospital, and had
been there for nearly a year. In connection with
this, will you inform us of the date of the death
of Charles W. Coburn, Otis W. Wallace or of any of the others
who went from this Town in this Co. & Reg.

Will you be so kind as to send us a certificate
of the names of those who enlisted from this Town
in Co. D. 5th Maine Reg. by so doing you will confer a
blessing to us, and others.
