Dow - Franklin P. Davis - Thomas C. Grady - Thomas
Swett - Peter Lapointe - Joseph Ricard & Elbridge
Peltier. On ^{the} accompanying Descriptive Roll rec^d this
day (28th) were borne thirteen (13) names of which
four only were rec^d, the Officer in charge of them not
knowing whether the remainder left Maine or desert
ed on the way. The following are the names of
those not-rec^d. viz. Joseph Bonsha - Alexander Fletcher -
Walter G. Hanson - Charles Hicks - Everett Legare -
Thomas Argue - Louis Sharpes - George Troop - &
Henry Thompson

I forwarded to you last eve - the
Annual Report of this Regt.: it would have been
forwarded sooner; but your request for the same
being rec^d during my absence, and the Adjutant
soon after going to Maine, it was overlooked for
a number of days.
