To the Governor and Council.

I here with transmit Copies of two letters recd. from Colonel Starwood requesting the removal of the Gun House in the town of Brunswick (from the Division) together with Copies of my letters to Colonel Starwood and Capt Welch upon the same subject.

I have taken measures to ascertain from the Adj. Genl of Massachusetts whether any title by deed or lease of the land upon which the Gun house now stands had ever been obtained, and do not find that any such title exists.
