Enclosed I send you duplicate receipts for two National Colors and one Camp Color. One of the National Colors is at Augusta now, sent there by Col Seaman if I recollect right, The other one is at Bethel. Col Edwards wished to use it to day at the Funeral of the late Major Robinson of the 4th Maine Battery and then he wished me to say that he would forward that with the Camp Color to you by Express, and as we are about to send our Agent to Washington with the accounts of the Officers, to have them immediately adjusted, it is very important that I should have the receipt for the Colors immediately. And if you will be so kind as to sign them and send to me I will see that the Colors are promptly sent to you. The Officers have accounted for the Company Books in some other way, and I will send them to you as soon as they are

done with them
