Enclosed you have the accounts of
Brig. Brown, Tainer, at Ellsworth, ~~for~~ the bond of
Capt Sirri Scott, a state prisoner, which he has
requested me to send to you for allowance & payment.

Finding that Scott had resolved not to cite
me, & disclose as the law provides; but had determined
to remain in jail, as long as the state would pay
his bond, I thought it best, to save further expense,
and ordered him discharged. — This is the same Capt S.
about whom I wrote Gov. Sanfords recently.

I have not upon the enclosed bills at
your next session and advise me or Mr Brown
of the result —
