Enclosed you have the accounts of
Brig. Brown, Tiler, at Ellsworth, & the bond of
Capt. Eric Scott, a state prisoner, which he has
requested me to send to you for allowance & payment.

Finding that Scott had resolved not to cede
me, & disclose as the law provides; but had determined
to remain in jail, as long as the state would pay
his bond, I thought it best, to save further expense,
and ordered him discharged. — This is the sum Capt. S.
about whom I write Gov. Sanborn recently.

Please act upon the enclosed bills at
your next session and advise me or Mr. Brown
of the result —
