I enlisted as a recruit in the 5th
Regt. Me^t Vol^t Co. F. on the 11th day
of January 1862 (was enlisted by
Otho C. Merrill) and was mustered
into U.S. Service on the 22 of January
1862. I contend, my old Descriptive
List (Co. F. 5th Me) gives my date of
muster, March 6th 1862, at which
time I was on my way to join my
Regt. with a squad in command of
Capt Patch, assisted by Lieuts. ^{5th Me} Fernald,
Brown, 1st Me,

I was wounded May 3^d 1863
at Battl of Chancellorsville, and
am now attached to the 44th Co
2nd Battalion Vet. Res. Corps, on duty at
Judiciary Square Hospital, this City.
By granting my request, you will
greatly oblige, Your humble Servt.
