\* ASSURANCE OF DISCONTINUANCE  
\*  
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Pursuant to the Unfair Trade Practices Act, 5 M.R.S.A. § 206, et seq., the Attorney General has examined Jeanne Payson's, d/b/a Payson's Draperies and Slipcovers (hereinafter referred to as Payson's) practices regarding the acceptance of downpayments in her drapery business and has found the following facts:

Payson's has accepted downpayments from consumers in this State for the purchase of drapery material and the sewing of finished drapes. Payson's, however, has failed either to deliver finished drapes to those persons or to return to them the amount of their downpayments. The Attorney General believes that Payson's conduct violates 5 M.R.S.A. § 207.

Therefore, pursuant to 5 M.R.S.A. § 210, Payson's assures that it will

1. discontinue the practices described in this Assurance, and
2. pay to the Attorney General, in weekly installments of \$25.00 beginning 7 days after this Assurance is

restitution to aggrieved consumers. )
