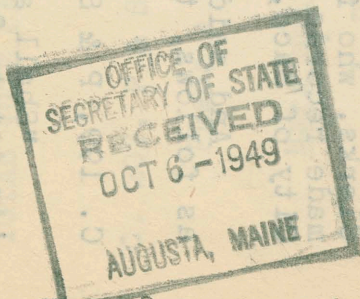

TO: THE SECRETARY OF STATE, state House, Augusta, Maine.

At legal meetings of the inhabitants of the several wards in the City of Saco, qualified by the Constitution to vote for State and County Officers, holden on the First Monday of October, being the Third day of said month, in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and Forty-nine.

The said inhabitants gave in their votes upon Referendum Questions to change or to amend the Charter of the City of Saco, Maine.

And the same were received, sorted, counted and declared in open Ward Meetings, by the Wardens who presided, and in the presence of the Ward Clerks, who formed lists of the whole number of ballots given in and made records which were forthwith delivered to the City Clerk of the said City of Saco, Maine.

And said records were received by said City Clerk and recorded as follows, to wit:
