## DEPARTMENT FOR LADIES, IN THE Bangor Commercial College.

Business Education for Ladies.

The large numbers of young ladies who require a sound commercial education, in order to perform efficiently the duties which grow upon them, and to meet the wants of their families, have caused the establishment of the Department to be established.

The design is, to prepare ladies thoroughly for the duties of the Counting House, the Merchant and Manufacturer. The course of instruction and general plan of the Business Training, will be identical with that of the male department.

The situations in business now open for competent ladies are numerous, owing to the large drain of young men from the channels of trade during the late war.

The suggestion recently made by a board of merchants, that "the male help in our banks, insurance and express offices, and retail and wholesale dry-goods houses, go to strengthen our army, and their places given to well qualified females," meeting with general favor then, proves beyond doubt the adaptation of ladies to fill these positions.

All these vacancies must, yet can, be filled only with those competent for the duties involved. This College eminently supplies this deficiency in the knowledge of business; and young ladies, in twelve or eighteen weeks, according to ability, at small expense, are prepared, by practice and theory, to step right into any department of trade.

**Actual Business.**

As there is in all departments of Education a science which the practice must accord, however the forms of the latter may vary, a thorough course of instruction to develop the theory of that science is indispensable to every book-keeper.
